**Nov. 16** - Registration for in-district residents and skaters previously registered in Fall 2009 session.  
**Nov. 18** - Open registration.

In-district fee applies to Skokie & Morton Grove residents. Non-resident figure skating fees are 15% additional. Patrons may register at any Skokie Park District facility. Registrations received by mail prior to starting date will be processed on second day of registration. The facility's Main Office accepts all program registration outlined in this brochure.
